

Machine Quilted Blanket

A man who belongs to the Lafayette quilting club showed a neat way to machine quilt a blanket. Here it is:

Starting about 6" from the edge of the quilt, sew a line down the side of the blanket.

Stop about 6" from the end, turn the quilt, then do the same through the rest of the blanket, making a spiral until you reach the middle.

This goes very quickly and makes the blankets look really nice! And, it's a good way to be sure that the batting is not going to slip!
