

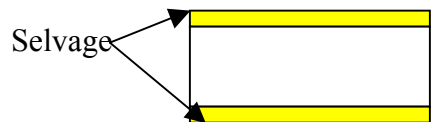
No-Sew Fringe Blanket

Materials needed:

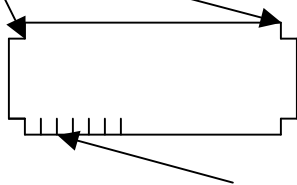
- 1 yard of double sided fleece for child size blanket, **OR**
- 1 & 1/2 to 2 yards for teen size blanket
- Scissors (pinking shears give a nice effect, but plain scissors will work)
- Ruler

Directions:

Cut off the selvage (the finished edge). You will trim off about $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch down each side.



Cut a 4"x4" square out of each corner. (You can save these squares and, when you have enough, use them to make a patchwork blanket.)



Cut strips 1 inch wide and 4 inches deep around all four sides of the blanket. Polar fleece will not ravel, so you can use plain scissors, but pinking shears give a nice looking edge to the strips.

Tie an overhand knot on each strip to create finished fringe edge. (tie knot down close to blanket)
For a little different look after you have all the knots done, cut the fringe a second time down close to the knot- makes a nice look.

Variation:

For a heavier blanket, use two layers of polar fleece. Cut out each piece as described above, then tie a top and a bottom fringe together.
