Providing Security Through Blankets

Quick Quilt

Supplies:

2 yards of material for Side #1	1 skein of yarn (baby or sport yarn)
2 yards of material for Side #2	1 tapestry needle
2 yards of batting	1 spool of thread

Assembly:

Place Side 1 and Side 2 material with right sides facing each other.

Place the batting on top of the two layers.

Pin the three layers together.

At the bottom of the material, mark an opening of 6 to 12 inches for turning.

Sew all three layers together with a 3/4" seam allowance, leaving the opening unsewn.

Backstitch the beginning and ending stitches and, if necessary, reinforce the corners.

Trim the corners and turn the quilt right side out.

By hand, blind stitch the opening.

Finishing:

Around the entire quilt, machine stitch 1" from the edge. This will form the border.

Thread the tapestry needle with about 24" of sport yarn.

Select various sites to tack the quilt. (Tacking holds the batting in place and takes the place of actual quilting. Tacking should be about every 4".)

Inserting the needle from Side 1, go through Side 2.

Move the needle over about 1/8", insert from Side 2 back to Side 1.

Tie a knot twice and trim the yarn to about 1/4" to 1/2" in length.

Tack each selected site in this manner.
